Transferring in Spring: Professional Sequence coursework begins (must have completed ECE 1, ECON (1A or 1B), MATH 14, PSYC 1A, SOC 1, SOC 25, HUSV 70 (formerly SOC 70) BIO 5, and BIO 6 at Shasta or equivalents at Chico by start of Spring) Transferring in Fall: must have most pre-requisites for Professional Sequence completed (can take Chico equivalents to ECE 1, SOC 25, and HUSV 70 (formerly SOC 70) as well as Upper Division GE in Fall)
