<b>Type of term</b>	15-week traditional semester
<b>Typical length of the program</b>	4 semesters (2 years)
<b>Option to do program part-time?</b>	Program is designed to be completed full-time. Students can do the program on a part-time basis, but it is much more financially economical to complete as a full-time student. <b>Cost per term or per course</b>	\$3,905/semester for full-time; \$2,699/semester for part-time (6 units or less)
<b>Average tuition cost for entire program</b>	\$15,620 (if attending full-time for four semesters)
<b>Books/Supplies</b>	\$1,275-1,600 total (cost varies depending on textbooks rentals, buying used vs. new, etc)
