| Typical length of the program | 4 semesters, full-time (15 months) or 6-8 semesters if part-time |

It allows students to "get ahead" by completing BSN courses, through CSUDH College of Extended Education, during summers while in the ADN program. Ideally, students will begin dual enrollment at the very beginning of the ADN program but students who have completed 1-3 semesters are also welcome. |
| Actual units required for nursing curriculum | Can take up to 19 units that can be transferred to CSUDH BSN |

Completing coursework through CSUDH Dual Enrollment Extended Education is not a guarantee of getting admitted to CSUDH's BSN program., however, they have been able to accommodate qualified applicants. Also, participating in the pre-BSN program can mean finishing the CSUDH RN to BSN program in only one year. |
