Type of term	Six 8-week terms per year (a semester is two 8-week terms)
Typical length of the program	Seven terms (1 year and 8 weeks) if full-time taking 2 classes/term (6 units) and the required 78 units were transferred in; program will take longer if student is part-time and/or transfers in fewer than the 78 units.

Cost per term or per credit hour	\$370 per credit hour; \$250 military per credit hour (cost includes books) 2018-2019
Average tuition cost for entire program	\$15,540 based on a completion of 42 credit hours in an academic year.
