Student must hold active, unencumbered RN license to take coursework	Yes. Student may submit application, but it will be flagged as incomplete until proof licensure is provided.
Student must be employed in a licensed RN job	No. This program is designed for students to transition directing from their ADN program.
Space available	Space is not an issue.
Demand/impaction	There is no wait list. As more students enroll, more instructors can be hired.
When can a person start the program?	August, October, January, February, May or June
Application Process	Apply online. \$35 fee waived for students participating in the Associate to Bachelor's (A2B) program. Several follow up steps involving transcripts and any test scores: http://web.ccis.edu/online/admissions.aspx
Type of term	Six 8-week terms per year (a semester is two 8-week terms)
Typical length of the program	Seven terms (1 year and 8 weeks) if full-time taking 2 classes/term (6 units) and the required 78 units were transferred in; program will take longer if student is part-time and/or transfers in fewer than the 78 units.
Recency requirements	Any course taken more than 8 years ago should be assessed by Columbia College for transfer equivalency.
Option to do program part-time?	Yes
Cost per term or per course	\$375/unit (active military \$250/unit) For 2016-17
Average tuition cost for entire program	\$15,750 (if 78 semester units applied to degree and using current tuition rate)
Books/Supplies	Zero; textbooks are included in online courses, no extra cost for texts
