Cost per term or per course	\$250 per credit; \$3,757 based on 15 credits per term
Average tuition cost for entire program	If transferring in 80 semester units (120 quarter credits), total tuition cost will be approximately \$15,000 If transferring in only 60 semester units (90 quarter credits), total tuition cost will be approximately \$20,000
