Application Process	Submit online application: http://academicpartnerships.uta.edu/apply.aspx Submit official transcripts to UT Arlington Admissions. After "Transfer Credit Report" is created in your MyMav Student Center, records will be forwarded to College of Nursing who will evaluate for final application evaluation.
Type of term	5 weeks terms: students take one course every 5 weeks with 1 week break between courses.
Typical length of the program	9 months for nursing coursework (additional month for Texas State History course and any additional general courses)

Limitations on repeated courses	No penalty. If course is repeated, higher grade will be used for admissions
