Welcome

The meeting was called to order at 3:08 p.m. Carolyn welcomed everyone to the meeting noting that it was the last meeting for the semester.

Approval of Minutes – September 27, 2012

The minutes from the September 27, 2012 meeting were reviewed with one correction to be made in reference to the Barclay's California Code of Regulations: Title 5, Section 55063 on page 2. Carolyn will provide the correct verbiage for the correction via email to note-taker. No other corrections were noted. Motion to approve the minutes with the corrected information/motion carried.

CSU GE and IGETC – course approval

Biology 10 and 10L – Carolyn explained that the BIOL 10 course was submitted to have the Lab portion split out as a separate course. The course content remains the same. The lab would be 1 unit and lecture would be 3 units. These courses are in Areas B2 and B3 on the CSU General Education pattern and Areas 5B and 5C on the IGETC pattern. The change will be reflected in the next catalog and on ASSIST.

A motion was made to approve and submit the changes for the CSU GE and IGETC patterns; M/S: Tate/Redd. Motion carried.

History 2 World Civilization to 1500 B.C. and History 3 World Civilization 1500 – Present - It was noted that these social science courses could also qualify under Humanities on the CSU GE and IGETC patterns. In addition to the current listing (D6: History and Area 4 Social and Behavioral Sciences) these courses would be listed in C2: Humanities on the CSU GE pattern and Area 3 Humanities on the IGETC pattern. It was also noted that on the Associates Degree – General Education pattern the courses would be listed in both #2 Social and Behavioral Sciences and #3 Humanities.

A motion was made to approve HIST 2 and 3 for the Humanities areas on all three of the General Education patterns; M/S: Maxwell/Fulton. Motion carried. These courses will be submitted for CSU and IGETC approval by the December 14th state deadline.
