1. **Welcome**

Meeting called to order at 3:08pm by Carolyn Borg.

2. **Approval of Minutes from 2-23-17**

Additions? – No Yes

Susan Westler moved and Roxi Redd seconded to approve the minutes of the February 23, 2017 meeting. They were approved with the only notation being that Roxi Redd said there was no “e” at the end of her first name, which is the way it has been listed in previous minutes. The minutes were unanimously approved.

3. **Opportunity for Public Comment** – None

4. **GE Committee By-Laws -- Brown Act Committee**

Carolyn Borg talked about the fact that the GE Committee is a Brown Act Committee and discussed the rules associated with that.

5. **Election of Faculty Co-Chair**

Carolyn said she is the Co-Chair from Counseling and John Yu is the Co-Chair from Administration. Lenore Frigo nominated Carolyn Borg to be Co-Chair again this year, seconded by Susan Westler, carried without opposition. Carolyn said we will need a new Co-Chair next year, as this may be her last year as co-chair and she hopes to train a replacement.

6. **Committee Membership** - There were no corrections on the Committee Membership listing (attached).

7. **Standards of Approval for GE Courses** - Carolyn Borg explained the three GE patterns:

- A. California State Universities – E.O. 1100
- B. IGETC: for UC and CSU -- IGETC Standards 1.8
- C. Local Associate GE pattern – Title 5

These patterns are outlined in the attached documents, and they are available in the Catalog and on the General Education website. Carolyn noted that course units cannot be counted twice, but a course can sometimes satisfy more than one GE area.

8. **2017-18 CSUGE and IGETC responses** – We have yet to receive the formal response from the State on last year’s courses that were submitted. Some courses were submitted last year in order to split out the lecture and lab to make them separate courses. As a result, BIOL 12L, ESCI 14L and NHIS 15L were denied. Carolyn said the Course Outline of Record (COR) for the lab course needs to list a separate lab manual and were denied for that reason. Carolyn appealed in

June which was granted by the CSU system for the CSU pattern but not for IGETC. All the courses we submitted to CSU were approved –ASTR 2H, BIOL 10H, BIOL 12L, ESCI 14, ESCI 14L, HUM 2H, NHIS 5L. A brand new course, Health 6 - Culture and Health, was approved for the Social Sciences area, Area “D”.

The three labs submitted for IGETC were denied, but we can resubmit them when the lab manuals are included in the COR. This is from the lab lecture split. The following Honors courses were approved for the IGETC pattern: Astronomy (ASTR 2H), Biology (BIOL 10H), Field Biology (BIOL 12), Intercultural Communication (CMST 20H), Public Speaking (CMST 60H), Psychology (PSYC 1AH) and Sociology (SOC 1H), ENGL 1AH, ENGL 1BH, and ENGL 1CH. BIOL 12 and ESIC 14 were also approved. Small Group Communication Honors (CMST 54H) was not approved for IGETC, and since it’s a CSU requirement it should duplicate the approval granted by CSU. Carolyn said she will follow up on that. The transition from ASSIST legacy to ASSIST NextGen has resulted in a few snags this year.

Carolyn is not aware of any new classes going through Curriculum for GE right now.

9. Guided Pathways – GE Discussion

Universities throughout the country are working on Guided Pathways, which identified degree pathways for college students rather than a high school student initiative. \$150 million was designated by the Governor to implement Guided Pathways throughout California. John suggested faculty should get involved in the Pathways to help choose which GE classes are best for various programs. As the General Ed Committee we may want to think about which courses work best with other classes, and we can even develop a thematic approach to this. Guided Pathways provides a more directed approach for students.

10. New GE courses from other community colleges

Carolyn will provide samples to the next meeting.

11. Other?

Greg Thorson asked if THTR 81 can be added to the GE Pattern.
