In order to participate in the College to Career (C2C) Program, you need to apply to Shasta College, the DSPS program, and the Department of Rehabilitation. All steps must be completed for you to start classes as a College to Career student.

### *Apply to College to Career Program*

2. Fill out the College to Career application, available on [shastacollege.edu/StudentServices/DSPS](http://shastacollege.edu/StudentServices/DSPS)

(applications received by April 15<sup>th</sup> will receive full consideration, applications received after this date will be considered if space is available)

3. Submit the application according to instructions on the form
