Community Resources

Carr Fire Disaster Recovery Center is open in Redding to provide recovery assistance services to residents impacted by the Carr Fire. It will be open from 9:00 a.m. - 7:00 p.m. 8 at the old K-Mart building (2685 Hilltop Drive). The purpose of the center is to assist communities by providing centralized location for services and resource referrals for needs following the fire.
