Drug and Alcohol Division

The Drug and Alcohol Division offers education, prevention, and treatment services for men, women and adolescents 12-17. Pregnant and/or parenting women are encouraged to access our perinatal services* with gender specific treatment groups. Admission preference is given to pregnant women. Staff is committed to the alleviation of problems caused by substance use/dependence.

Services Available:

- Screening, assessment, group counseling, prevention and education classes .
- Perinatal services for pregnant and parenting women including intensive outpatient, outpatient, case management, transportation and child care.
- Referrals to adult residential treatment services.
- Treatment services available in Spanish.
- Adolescent services offer age specific education and treatment groups.
- Co-occurring treatment groups provided in coordination with the Mental Health Division.
- CalWORKs assessment, treatment, and case management services in cooperation with the Department of Social Services.
- Outreach services including screenings, assessments, and educational groups are provided to the Jail, Juvenile Detention Facility and Day Reporting Center.

Prevention Services

Drug and alcohol education and prevention services are provided to Tehama County Schools. Activities include prevention projects, National Awareness Months, Red Ribbon Week, and the outreach to local fairs.
