



Accepting Applications for The Woodlands Apartments complex

The Woodlands includes 34 units for families and another 19 units that will be permanent supportive housing through the Mental Health Service Act (MHSa) program. One unit will be designated for the on-site property manager.

Target Population for Family Apartments

Of the 34 units available to families, 14 units will be 2 bedroom and 20 units will be 3 bedroom. The project targets families with lower incomes based on area median incomes established by funding agencies.

Target Population for MHSa Apartments

These apartments are for people who are eligible for MHSa services and have serious mental illness and are also homeless or at risk of homelessness (as defined by the MHSa Housing Program). This affordable housing is designed for people who would benefit from mental health services linked with housing. MHSa eligibility will be determined by Shasta County Health and Human Services Agency.
